Rams Host NFL High School Player Development Camp

As part of the Rams commitment to youth football, the club once again partnered with the National Football League to host the 2011 High School Player Development Camp. HSPD serves as a free resource for both high school players and coaches. Camp features included character development, life skills, on-field techniques, motivational speakers, skill development and time management instruction.
